

Prof. Dr. Nataša Poklar Ulrih (UL BF – Chair for Biochemistry and Food Chemistry) (F) is a full professor of biochemistry and a vice-dean of Science and Research at Biotechnical Faculty. She obtained her PhD in 1994 at Faculty of Chemistry and Chemical Technology at University of Ljubljana. As a post-doctoral fellow, she had an appointment at The Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, as a visiting professor at University of Toronto and University of California Santa Cruz (as Fulbright fellow). She has been successfully coordinating many national and international projects. Her research interests are the interactions of small molecules with biological macromolecules, identification of small molecules, polyphenols and other natural compounds, developing the new technologies (nanobased) for encapsulation of small molecules and plant extracts. She has published more than 130 peer review articles, two patents and two patent applications.
